February 23, 2021

The regular meeting of the Common Council of the City of Platteville was called to order by Council President Daus at 7:00 PM. Due to a special presentation and COVID-19 Pandemic, this meeting was conducted by both in person at 1155 N. Second St. and by digital means via Zoom.

Motion carried 7-0 on a roll call vote.

- A. Board/Commission/Committee Minutes – Community Safe Routes Committee, Water & Sewer Commission, Museum Board, Parks, Forestry, & Recreation Committee, Library Board, and Airport Commission.

ACTION

- A. *Sidewalk Policy* – David Ralph, 75 N Oak St., Danica Larson, 1010 7th Ave., and Kristina Fields, 945 Seventh Ave, all spoke in favor of option 3 for the Sidewalk Policy. Motion by Artz, second by Kilian to approve Sidewalk Policy Option 3. Daus amended the motion to include that PAIDC will be involved in sidewalk discussions in the industrial park. Motion carried 4-3 with Shanley, Nickels, and Kopp voting against.

INFORMATION AND DISCUSSION

- A. *Contract 2-21, Business 151 Sidewalk* – Public Works Director Howard Crofoot explained the project is to install a sidewalk from the intersection of Water Street along the south side of Business Highway 151 to the David Canny Rountree Branch Trail at Valley Road. There were 7 bidders on this project. The low bidder is G-Pro Excavating with a bid of \$70,929.50 and staff recommends approval.

WORK SESSION – PAA and Five Bugles Fire Department Comprehensive Analysis. Tim Franz and Jim Austad presented for PAA, Public Administration Associates, LLC. Steve Gausman and Laura Eysnogle presented for Five Bugles. Together they gave a presentation to the Common Council and the City of Platteville on the Fire Department Comprehensive Analysis.

Motion by Kopp, second by Nickels to adjourn. Motion carried 7-0 on a roll call vote. The meeting was adjourned at 9:38 PM.
