

TEAM CAPTAINS:

Be sure your players have registered for an ActiveNet Account before participating on the court. The team roster form will be due in the Recreation office on or before the start of the first night of play. The last day to add new players is **the sixth week of play** in the Recreation office by 4:30 p.m. **Captains should initial the score sheet for accuracy.**

LEAGUE INFORMATION:

A. Games:

- I. Best of five games will be played. Games one through four are to 25, rally score. If a fifth game is necessary, it will be played to 15 with rally score.
- II. Score of 25 points (or 15 in a fifth game) with a win by 2 points for a total of at least three games to be played with the possibility for one or two more.
- III. Begin at 6:30 p.m. (If needed, 7:30 p.m. and 8:30 p.m.) A 10-minute grace period at the start of the first game of the match and 5 minutes for each subsequent game.
- IV. Maximum number of players on each court is 6 with a minimum of 3.
- V. Rock, paper, scissors to determine serve or side.
- VI. Rules of Play including: Playing the Ball, Ball at the Net, Player at the Net, Service, Attack Hit, and Block will be adopted from the most recent version of "Rules of the Game/Volleyball" published by FIVB.
- VII. Teams are to call their own fouls. If there is a disagreement on a call, then re-play the point.
- VIII. The scorekeeper will record scores and assist with any questions.

B. Teams:

- I. Shall be comprised of equal numbers of genders, or a combination that is off by one. Individual players should enroll as the gender they identify as. Non-binary players are welcome.
- II. Teams without the minimum players at the start of the match may be asked for forfeit at the discretion of their opponent.
- III. First and second place teams will receive a chamber gift certificate.

C. Cancellations / Forfeits


- I. If your team must forfeit, please contact the Recreation office: (608) 348-1833 by 4:00 pm as well as the team you are scheduled to play.
- II. If the weather is questioned, a decision to cancel will be made prior to 4:30 p.m. Team captains will be contacted via email or text message; or they can call the Recreation Hotline (608-348-4067) or check the Platteville Parks & Recreation Facebook page. Information will be put on the Hotline and Facebook page as soon as it is available. A decision after 4:30 p.m. will be made at program site. Cancelled games may be rescheduled at the end of the regular season.


D. Alcohol is prohibited on park grounds.
